Notification of essential maintenance works adjacent to the A14 and within Southfield Farm Marsh

I am writing to let you know that we will be carrying out essential maintenance work adjacent the A14 between Junction 9 and Junction 10, and within Southfield Farm Marsh.

During our work we will clear pipework beneath the A14 which brings spring water to Southfield Farm Marsh.

Our work is being undertaken in consultation with Natural England, The Wildlife Trust and local land owners. This work will improve drainage and enhance the SSSI as part of our commitment to improving and understanding environmental impacts of our work and the strategic road network. It will also reduce the need for further maintenance works in this location.

When will the work take place?

Work will take place between **26th July and 25th August 2021**.

We will be delivering our daytime work between **7am and 5pm, Monday to Friday between 26th July and 6th August** within Southfield Farm Marsh. With vehicular access via Gotch Road / Blackwell Road to the north of the A14 and Southfield Drive to the south of the A14.

We will also be undertaking work overnight on the A14 between **8pm and 6am, Monday to Friday between 6th August and 25th August**.

Please note that our planned works are dependent on agreements with adjacent landowners and subject to change due to weather conditions, significant events or unforeseen circumstances.

How will the work affect traffic?

To maintain a safe environment for our workforce and motorists on the A14, the following closures will be in place during this time.

Lane closures of the eastbound and westbound A14 between junction 9 to 10. Closure of the eastbound exit slip at junction 10.

How will the work affect businesses and residents?

During these works, access to businesses and residences will be maintained. During these closures, we will put in place fully signed diversion routes which have been agreed with the Local Authority. We respectfully ask that all vehicles follow the diversion route which will help minimise the overnight disturbance experienced by the communities in the surrounding area.

We apologise for any inconvenience caused and will do our very best to complete the work as quickly as possible, keeping disturbances and noise to a minimum.

Maintaining safety during Covid-19


